

ARCHANGELO CORELLI (1653-1713) Corelli was a great Italian violinist, teacher and composer. He had many fine students. He wrote exclusively for strings and developed the art of violin playing to a high degree in his time. He, with Tartini, was responsible for changing the shape of the outward curved bow to a shape which led Francois Tourte about 35 years later to develop the modern bow. He was a master of beautiful melody and harmony. This piece is composed in the harmonic style of Corelli. Notice the interesting combinations of sound.
